



Nutrition and Dietetics



The Dietetics major prepares students towards becoming a Dietetic Technician, Registered (DTR), completing a Dietetic Internship, or continuing to acquire a Master of Science in Nutrition and Dietetics and become a Registered Dietitian Nutritionist (RDN).

The undergraduate Didactic Program in Dietetics (DPD) is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Education in Nutrition and Dietetics (ACEND).



The Nutrition minor provides students with a more in-depth study of nutrition in clinical care, nutritional sciences, sports nutrition, and nutrition wellness. It is an ideal component to majors related to nutrition such as exercise science, public health, athletic training, child development, psychology, and other majors that lead into the medical field.
