ACTIVITIES:

- Administration of scholarship funds that assist Michigan residents in pursuing training in dietetics, leading to active membership in the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics and Registered Dietitian status
- Administration of support for educational activities for Registered Dietitians in Michigan
- Administration of support for research activities related to dietetic education and practice in Michigan

ORGANIZATION: The Michigan Nutrition and Dietetics Institute, Inc. is a tax-exempt foundation established by the Michigan Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics (MiAND) in 1980. A Board of Trustees including Michigan Academy members and public members guide the activities of the Institute. A majority of the Trustees are elected from and by the membership of the MiAND.

MNDI BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The affairs of the Institute are managed by the Board of Trustees, each of whom shall serve as a volunteer. A Trustee supports the MNDI mission and prioritized annual activities that support the Institute.

TERM OF OFFICE

The Board is composed of nine (9) Trustees who are MiAND members. A Trustee holds office for a term of three (3) years beginning July 1 following the MiAND elections. Trustee responsibilities will progress each year of the term. The Board of Trustees' responsibilities include accepting contributions, establishing criteria for disbursement of funds, and enhancing the visibility and credibility of the Institute.

POSITIONS

- Scholarship Track: First year Committee Member, second year Presidentelect/Scholarship Chair, third year President
- Fundraising/Treasurer Track: First year Committee Member, second and third year Treasurer or Fundraising Chair depending on the year
- Communications Track: First year Committee Member, second year Communications Chair, third year Secretary

TRUSTEE MEETINGS

- The Annual Board of Trustees meeting is held in June where the Officers for the next year are elected.
- The Board of Trustees meets at least three
 (3) times each year with the Executive Board
- Additional Committee meetings may be held between Board meetings.

CRITERIA FOR OFFICE

- Voting member of the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics (AND) and MiAND for at least three (3) consecutive years preceding nomination
- Experience in district and/or state dietetic association activities and familiarity with the state association
